Our Vision

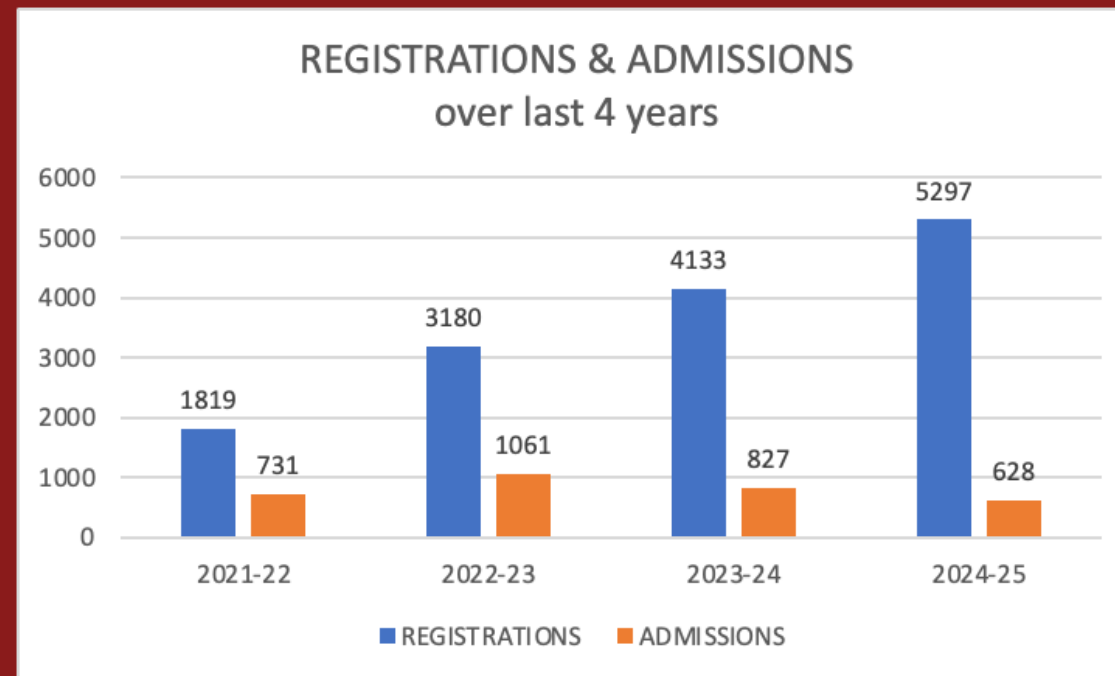
To be a school of innovation and creativity, Preparing students for global challenges.

Student Enrollment

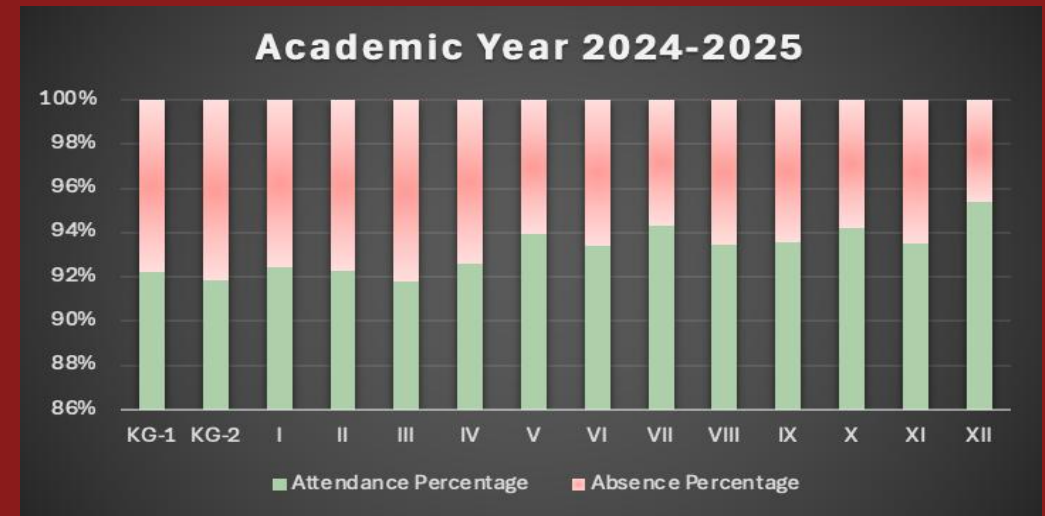
- The number of student registrations have grown steadily from 2021-22 to 2024-25, showing increasing popularity and demand for admissions.
